Counted toys, blocks, and snacks throughout the day. She understands one-to-one correspondence.

Sep 3, 2026 • Science • Plant observation

Drew pictures of plants we saw at the library garden. Asked thoughtful questions about how plants grow.

Sep 4, 2026 • Reading • Blending sounds

Sounded out simple CVC words (cat, dog, hat). Getting more confident with blending.
